

# U.I.L. Eligibility Calendar 2015-16

DATE OF GRADE CHECK	DATE ELIGIBILITY IS LOST / GAINED	STUDENT ELIGIBILITY STATUS
October 2, 2015	October 9, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
October 23, 2015	October 30, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 1st six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
November 6, 2015	November 13, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
November 30, 2015	December 7, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 2nd six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
December 18, 2015	January 12, 2016	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period become ineligible. (See Holiday Rule)
January 25, 2016	February 1, 2016	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 3rd six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
February 19, 2016	February 26, 2016	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
March 11, 2016	March 28, 2016	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 4th six-weeks grading period remain eligible. (See Holiday Rule)
April 15, 2016	April 22, 2016	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
May 06, 2016	May 13, 2016	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the 3 week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the 5th six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
	<b>1st 6-wks ELIGIBILITY</b>	Eligibility for students during the 1st 6-weeks - see page 3 of the TEA/UIL Side By Side
	<b>GRACE PERIOD</b>	All Grading and Evaluation periods are followed by a 7 day grace period which ends at the end of the school day.
	<b>HOLIDAY RULE</b>	All Students are academic eligible during a school holiday of a full calendar week or more.
