

TSI Prep:

It is highly encouraged that students prepare for the exam by reviewing practice questions. Below are a few recommended resources to help students prep for the TSI:

TSI Scores:

Students will receive their scores immediately upon the completion of testing. Below are the score requirements for college/dual-credit enrollment:

Math: 350

Reading: 351

Writing: 340 with a 4 on the essay OR any score with a 5 on the essay.

TSI Exemptions:

Students may be considered exempt from the TSI/College Ready if they meet any of the following criteria:

- SAT Math score of 530+ = exempt in TSI Math
- SAT Evidenced Based Reading and Writing score of 480+ = exempt in TSI Reading and Writing
- ACT Composite score of 23 with a 19+ in Math = exempt in TSI Math
- ACT Composite score of 23 with a 19+ in English = exempt in TSI Reading & Writing

TSI Testing Info

The TSI is Texas' College Readiness Exam. Any student planning to attend a PUBLIC college in Texas (either 2-year, like ACC and Blinn, or 4-year, like Texas State or UNT) must complete the TSI exam before enrolling. Scores on this exam do not determine college admission (that's what the SAT and ACT are for); rather, the TSI is used to determine which classes a student can enroll in. All seniors are encouraged to complete the TSI, unless they qualify for the TSI exemptions (see below). Underclassmen planning to take dual-credit courses at ACC also need to complete the TSI.

The TSI includes three sections: Reading, Writing, and Math. It is not a timed test, so students can take as long as they need to on each section of the test. Crockett offers this exam, for free, to students during the school day on specific dates each month. Students can sign up for a test date and time in the College & Career Center two weeks prior to test date. For further questions about the TSI, please contact Ann McClain.
