Dual Language Academy Code of Conduct

The Dual Language staff is very pleased that you want to be part of the Dual Language Academy. We assure you that it is a worthy goal. The rules and policies governing the Dual Language Academy are stricter than those pertaining to our general student body. For this reason, it is very important that you read this information carefully so that you understand what our school and our staff expect from you as a representative of our school.

Expectations for Students in Dual Language

1. Students are expected to represent Crockett in a positive manner.
2. Students are expected to maintain an attendance percentage over 90%
3. Students are expected to use appropriate language.
4. Students are expected to show respect to staff and other students.
5. Students are expected to maintain composure and professionalism at all times.
6. Students are expected to enjoy contributing and participating in the Dual Language program.

Philosophy

Our desire is to be “Always Victorious” every class day, within the community, and in the classroom in keeping with the school motto. However, we will not risk our integrity or our physical, emotional, or spiritual well being within this process. Our staff is always here to support and guide. We are confident that you will be a much better person because you were involved in the Dual Language Program at Crockett High School.

Academics

Your first responsibility at Crockett High School is to get the best education possible. You are very fortunate to have so many resources available to you. We expect you to attend class regularly, pay attention in class, turn in all required assignments, and study for tests.

*Minimum eligibility requirements for participation during the first nine weeks of the fall semester are as follows:

- 9th Grade – must have been promoted from the 8th grade.
- 10th Grade – must have 5 accumulated credits.
- 11th Grade – must have 10 accumulated credits or have earned 5 credits the previous semester.
- 12th Grade – must have 15 accumulated credits or have earned 5 credits the previous semester.

*Eligibility for the remainder of the year {1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th grading periods} is determined as follows:

Students must pass all Dual Language courses the previous nine weeks to avoid any type of academic probation.

These are only minimum requirements. We expect you to apply yourself in all your classes and that you be the best student you can be.

Participation

1. It is a privilege, not a right, to be in the Dual Language Academy at Crockett High School.
2. If you start a Dual Language course, we require you to finish at least a full semester of it before you can consider dropping it.
3. If you fail a dual language course within one semester your parents will be notified of your academic probation within the program. If you fail a dual language course within the whole year a meeting will be held with all dual language staff and parents to determine if you will continue to be in the Dual Language Academy.

Dress Code

1. Maintain a neat, clean, well-groomed appearance.
2. Clothing that suggests illegal drug use, or depicts lewdness, or use of profanity will not be worn on campus.
3. Follow the AISD dress code at all times.

Attendance Policy

1. School should not be missed except in cases of illness or family emergencies. Notes must be turned into your grade level office.
2. If it is necessary to schedule medical appointments during the school day, make every attempt to schedule them so you will not miss class work that is difficult to make up.
3. You will be responsible for make-up work in the classroom.
4. If you do miss school you will notify your Dual Language teachers immediately.
5. Unexcused absences and tardiness to school will not be tolerated and could result in removal from the Dual Language Academy.

Citizenship

1. You are a positive example for other students and we will expect you to conduct yourself positively at all times.
2. You will conduct yourself with dignity on campus and within the community.
3. All school rules and policies are in place at all extra curricular events on or off school property.
4. Should you seriously violate school rules that result in a campus review board hearing for placement at the alternative school, the dual language staff will be notified. Conditions for continued participation will be developed. Removal to ALC may result in dismissal from the Dual Language Academy.
5. Use of any illegal drug, including alcohol, on or off campus will not be tolerated and will be grounds for immediate dismissal from the Dual Language Academy as well as the imposition of school consequences.
6. Should your activity be in violation of the law, authorities will be contacted.
7. Should your behavior make it impossible for you to represent our school at any off campus events your parents will be contacted to pick you up at their expense.
