



Crockett Early College High School Advisory and Study Skills

At Crockett Early College High School, we strive to provide advising and study materials to our ECHS students in the following ways:

- All new ECHS students will meet with ECHS Coordinator one-on-one within the first 6 weeks of class to assess progress and develop individualized support plan.
- All students under Satisfactory Academic Progress (set by ACC) will meet with ACC Academic Advisor as well as with ECHS Coordinator to develop semester support plan within first 6 weeks of classes.
 - All Seniors will meet with ACC Academic Advisor and ECHS Coordinator one-on-one prior to commencement of their final year in the program to discuss completion plan.
- All ECHS students are cohorted into advisory sections, which meet twice weekly to discuss progress.
- All ECHS students are required to complete a midterm advising form (provided by ACC) every semester. All students earning below a C meet one-on-one with ACC Academic Advisor as well as with ECHS Coordinator to develop a support plan.
- All students have access to the Learning Lab (ACC) during their course time on Fridays, as well as during the regularly provided Learning Lab hours.
- All ECHS students have Academic Support time available to them on Fridays (when ACC is not in session). This time is used to access ACC support services, Academic Advising, and to study/prepare for upcoming course material.
