

## **Recommended TSI Assessment Version 2.0 (TSIA2) Prep:**

It is highly encouraged that students prepare for the TSIA2 exam by reviewing practice questions.

### **TSIA2 Testing Info:**

The TSIA2 is Texas' College Readiness Exam. Beginning January 11, 2021, the TSIA2 replaces the TSI. Any student planning to attend a PUBLIC college in Texas (either 2-year, like ACC and Blinn, or 4-year, like Texas State or UNT) must complete the TSIA2 exam before enrolling. Scores on this exam do not determine college admission; rather, the TSIA2 is used to determine which classes a student can enroll in. All seniors are encouraged to complete the TSIA2, unless they qualify for the TSIA2 exemptions (see below). Underclassmen planning to take dual-credit courses at ACC also need to complete the TSIA2.

The TSIA2 includes college readiness for: English language arts reading (ELAR) and math. It is not a timed test, so students can take as long as they need on each section of the test. Crockett offers this exam, for free, to students during the school day on specific dates each month. Students can sign up for a test date and time in the College & Career Center two weeks prior to test date, or can test by appointment with Ms. Capps in Room 269.

### **TSIA2 Scores:**

Students will receive their scores immediately upon the completion of testing. Below are the score requirements for college/dual-credit enrollment:

Math: 1. CRC score of 950 or

2. CRC below 950 with a diagnostic level of 6

ELAR: 1. CRC score of 945 and essay score of at least 5 or

2. CRC score below 945 and a diagnostic level of 5 or 6 and an essay score of at least 5

### **TSIA2 Exemptions:**

Students may be considered exempt from the TSIA2/College Readiness Classification if they meet any of the following criteria:

Math: 1. SAT Math score of 530+ or

2. ACT Composite score of 23+ with a 19+ in math

ELAR: 1. SAT Evidence Based Reading and Writing score of 480+ or

2. ACT Composite score of 23 with a 19+ in English
